### **MOTION FOR DETERMIATION OF WAIVER AND FOR BOARD'S FINAL ORDER BY HEARING NOT INVOLVING DSPUTED ISSUES OF MATERIAL FACT**

**TAB 1 Jackie Marei Denio-Waggoner, DOH Case No. 2014-03070, OT 13284,**

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## File # 13362 (PCP – Johnson, Mullings)

Ms. Denio-Waggoner, Respondent, was not present, and was not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board which consists of a one-count Administrative Complaint alleging the Respondent was terminated for cause from participation in the Medicaid Program. On November 18, 2013, the State of Florida's Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) informed the Respondent that she had failed to timely reimburse AHCA for the amount ordered by a Final Order issued on June 20, 2013. Accordingly, AHCA terminated Respondent's participation in the Medicaid program pursuant to Section 409.913(30), Florida Statutes. The termination became final on February 25, 2014.

Service of the Administrative Complaint was attempted via certified mail, but was unsuccessful. Hand service was made care of the manager at the marina where the Respondent resides. The manager stated all mail addressed to the Respondent goes through him and that he would forward the Administrative Complaint to the Respondent. However, in an abundance of caution, the Department still published a Notice of Action in the Broward Daily Business Review newspaper for four consecutive weeks on October 20, October 27, November 3 and November 10, 2014. Respondent failed to submit an election of rights or any other responsive pleading within the 21-day period to dispute the allegations contained in the Administrative Complaint. Therefore, this case was before the Board as a determination for waiver.

Ms. King informed the Board of a recent call received from Ms. Denio-Waggoner in response to the meeting notice. Ms. Denio-Waggoner indicated she was unaware of the Florida Department of Health's Administrative Complaint filed regarding her license. Ms. King provided a copy of the Administrative Complaint to the licensee via e-mail and referred her to the prosecuting attorney, Ms. Oaj Gilani, for any follow-up needed. Subsequently, Ms. Denio-Waggoner submitted a written statement which was presented to the Board for review during the meeting.

Allegation(s): Section 456.072(1)(kk), Florida Statutes (2013)

Disciplinary Guidelines: Section 456.072(1)(kk), Florida Statutes: First Offense, from a letter of Concern and a fine of \$1,000 to probation and a fine of \$1,000.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to find the Respondent was properly served and relinquished her right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the materials in Tab 1 and any addendums into evidence in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

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**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

Ms. McNulty reminded the Board of the e-mail received from Ms. Denio-Waggoner and requested the Board's discussion prior to making a motion to adopt the conclusions of law.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 486 and 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Ms. Roeck-Simmons made a motion to impose the following penalties as recommended by the Department:

- Reprimand
- \$1,000 fine payable within 6 months.

The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks moved to approve the Department's motion to assess costs in the amount of \$373.65, also payable within 6 months. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried 4/0 vote.

**TAB 3            Isaura Bou Melendez, DOH Case No. 2012-06808, OT 3177, File # 3004  
(PCP – Johnson, Mullings)**

Ms. Melendez, Respondent, was not present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board which consists of a one-count Amended Administrative Complaint alleging Respondent pled guilty of a crime relating to health care fraud. Respondent was involved in the submission of false or fraudulent claims to the Medicare program. Respondent was charged with and pled guilty to one count of Conspiracy to Commit Health Care Fraud in violation of Title 18, United States Code,

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Section 1347. On her Election of Rights Form, Respondent requested an informal hearing, meaning she does not dispute the issues of material fact alleged in the Amended Administrative Complaint, but would like the opportunity to present oral or written statements to the Board.

Allegation(s): Section 468.217(1)(x), and 456.072(1)(II), Florida Statutes (2012)  
Disciplinary Guidelines: Section 456.072(1)(II), Revocation and a fine of \$10,000, or in the case of application for licensure, denial of license.

Department's Recommended Penalty: Revocation

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to find the Respondent was properly served and has relinquished rights to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

#### **TAB 5          Jeffrey Jadoo, OTA by Examination, File #7101**

Mr. Jadoo was present, not represented by legal counsel, and sworn in by the court reporter. Dr. Martha Brown, Assistant Medical Director, representative for the Professionals Resource Network (PRN), attended the meeting on behalf of Mr. Jadoo.

Mr. Jadoo's application for licensure was reviewed previously by the Board as an individual consideration file during the November 3, 2014 meeting as a result of several prior misdemeanor criminal history incidents. The Board requested Mr. Jadoo complete a PRN evaluation and make a personal appearance before the Board. Mr. Jadoo successfully passed the OTA Exam and completed his NBCOT Certification on November 12, 2014.

On December 19, 2014, Mr. Jadoo completed a PRN evaluation and signed a 2 year contract with PRN on January 26, 2015. The contract includes that Mr. Jadoo may be reviewed for exit from the contract after one year of complete compliance. Dr. Brown attested on behalf of Mr. Jadoo's evaluation and contract with PRN.

### **PERSONAL APPEARANCE**

#### **TAB 26          Moore, Ryan Christopher, OTA by Endorsement, File # 6996**

Mr. Moore was present, not represented by legal counsel, and was sworn in by the court reporter.

Mr. Moore's application was submitted to the Board for review regarding unlicensed practice as an OTA from February 25, 2014 – July 21, 2014, prior to submitting his application for licensure.

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Board staff reported to the Compliance Unit the unlicensed activity upon receipt of Mr. Moore's personal statement submitted with his application. Mr. Moore's personal statement included acknowledging and requesting the Board's consideration for licensure with apology for not understanding the difference in his NBCOT COTA certification and the required Florida OTA license.

On November 10, 2014 Mr. Moore was issued a Cease and Desist and a Uniform Unlicensed Activity Citation in the amount of \$731.75. Mr. Moore paid the citation on October 27, 2014. Mr. Moore successfully completed the NBCOT COTA exam on November 17, 2014.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve Mr. Moore's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 6           Karia Anne Kline-Morris, OTA by Endorsement, File #7458**

Ms. Kline-Morris was not present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Kline-Morris' application was submitted for review by the Board due to "Yes" answers to previous criminal history.

Ms. Kline-Morris' submitted an application for licensure as an OTA by Endorsement including a personal written statement, documentation regarding her previous arrests, completion of court restitution and probation for each offense. Ms. Kline-Morris is currently licensed and working as an OTA in Missouri.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. McKenzie made a motion to require Ms. Kline-Morris to make a personal appearance before the Board at one of the next two scheduled meetings of the Board, for consideration of her application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 7           Stacy Venice Jackson, OTA by Examination, File #7406**

Ms. Jackson was not present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Jackson's application was submitted for review by the Board due to "Yes" answers to previous criminal history, health history of impairment, and disciplinary history regarding her Florida Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) license.

Ms. Jackson was disciplined by the Florida Board of Nursing on June 23, 2011, at which time her license was suspended with obligations, requiring an Intervention Project for Nurses (IPN) evaluation and compliance with required recommendations. IPN required Ms. Jackson to enter into a contract. Ms. Jackson's CNA license suspension was stayed while she was in compliance in the IPN program.

According to the Department's Compliance Unit, on December 31, 2014, IPN terminated Ms. Jackson's contract due to non-compliance.

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**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. McKenzie made a motion to deny licensure and allow Ms. Jackson 14 days to withdraw her application. If Ms. Jackson does not submit a request to withdraw her license within the 14 day period, a Notice of Intent to Deny will be issued. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 8 Megan Leigh White, OTA by Endorsement, File #16420**

Ms. White was not present for the meeting and submitted a letter of apology to the Board explaining she would not be able to attend the meeting due to being on maternity leave with a newborn.

Ms. White's application was submitted for review by the Board due to more than one Driving Under the Influence (DUI) charge within less than 10 years.

Ms. White is NBCOT certified, licensed and currently working and licensed in Minnesota and Louisiana.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried 4/0 vote.

### **TAB 14 NBCOT PRESENTATION - Shaun Conway, Director, Credentialing Services**

NBCOT Presentation - Shaun Conway, Director, Credentialing Services

Mr. Conway met with the Florida Board of Occupational Therapy Practice and administrative staff for the purpose of sharing the various enhancements made to programs and services of provided by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) and to dialogue with the Board and staff in an effort to further increase the efficiency and effectiveness of all NBCOT services.

Mr. Conway provided a PowerPoint presentation which included many NBCOT web and online service enhancements. One such enhancement is the Online Certification Verification search engine, for which Board staff relayed their commendations for streamlining Florida's Endorsement application process to the extent that licenses could be issued on the same day of receipt due to the immediate availability of this required document. Other services now available include weekly provision of examination scores to state regulatory boards, which has also decreased the time for Florida licensure of examination candidates.

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Lastly, Mr. Conway stated the NBCOT is committed to guiding certificants and continually advancing practice to ultimately improve client lives. He informed the Board of a new online educational competency tool, the NBCOT Navigator, which will be available soon after the NBCOT Annual Spring Conference. The Navigator will be free to all active OTR and COTA certificants to be able to chart their customized professional development path. The Navigator will include tools to verify practice strengths with case simulations, match games and quizzes, self-assessment tools, professional development registry access, PDU activities charting and thousands of evidence based research articles through ProQuest.

### **TAB 15          64B11-5.001 Requirements for License Renewal of an Active License; Continuing Education**

For the 2015 – 2017 licensure biennium, CE Broker will implement changes to licensee and provider reporting options based on the current version of the rule, reflecting the definitions of the recently implemented changes for interactive and home study courses, by the Board. Because of the importance of ensuring implementation of the Board's intent regarding new or revised provisions, the Board Staff asked the Board to provide direction to CE Broker and staff concerning several questions which have come up regarding various portions and specifics of the rule.

The Board reviewed the questions and gave staff feedback regarding the specific questions. With regard to allowing many varied avenues of obtaining credit by home study, the Board advised CE Broker to be consistent with the Board's Rules in allowing choices as long as the requirement of obtaining a CE certificate is mandated.

Additionally, the Board Staff inquired regarding several appeals requesting an exception to the 12 hour home-study restriction for courses offered by the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA), citing that the association's courses are generally of a higher caliber and often more stringent than many live offerings from other providers.

Upon advisement of Board Counsel due to other Boards' current battles with the Florida Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) regarding this same type of proposal, the Board decided to table this issue until a later date for review,

### TAB 17 Board Chair

Mr. Hicks acknowledged and welcomed Judith Johnson, Probable Cause Panel member for the Board, and Mr. Larry Gonzalez, Florida Occupational Therapy Association (FOTA) Lobbyist, and asked if they wish to address the Board. Ms. Johnson deferred to Mr. Gonzalez.

Mr. Gonzalez addressed the Board regarding a current “quiet crisis” in the profession within Florida for state employees and public officers. Mr. Gonzalez explained that the state group health plan, adopted by the legislature and administered by the Department of Management Services, discontinued coverage of occupational therapy services effective January 1, 2015.

Mr. Gonzalez explained that the FOTA is currently seeking to bring this issue to the attention of policy makers. He stated his understanding that this will require an amendment to the Appropriations Act. Mr. Gonzalez thanked many for their volunteer work, including Ms. McKenzie for her involvement and participation in planning meetings, and FAMU staff and students, who developed a white paper for the Legislature staff members to assist them in their understanding of the issue.

Mr. Gonzalez concluded his comments stating that as licensees and advocates for the profession of Occupational Therapy in Florida, this was the opportunity to use their individual as well as collective sphere to make an impact on the welfare of many state employees, public officers, and citizens of Florida.

Mr. Hicks also recognized and thanked Florida Agricultural & Mechanical University’s (FAMU’s) occupational therapy students and faculty representative for being present at the meeting.

Board staff prepares a Delegation of Authority and Conviction Record guideline matrices to be approved by the board each year. The matrices include basic clarifications in the descriptions, with only one additional delegation listed for a Pro Bono Liaison, to approve continuing education credit according to the provisions of Rule 64B11-5.001(15), F.A.C. This liaison would allow an expedited process by which licenses may receive approval without being required to potentially wait up to 3 months for consideration at a full meeting of the Board. When this delegation is approved, Board staff would ensure any request received include the information required in the rule, and promptly forward the request to the liaison for action.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve the amended delegations, with the exception of #12 regarding the Pro Bono delegation that will be removed from the delegations list until the rule development is complete and a need is established and approved for a liaison. The motion included the approval of the 2015 Conviction Record Guidelines as amended also. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried 4/0 vote.

### **TAB 22 SUNSHINE LAWS REFRESHER - DONNA MCNULTY**

Ms. McNulty presented a brief review of the Sunshine Laws to the Board.

The Sunshine Law provides a right of access to governmental proceedings at both the state and local levels. The law is equally applicable to elected and appointed boards and has been

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applied to any gathering of two or more members of the same board to discuss some matter, which will foreseeably come before that board for action.

## **TAB 23 HEALTHIEST WEIGHT INITIATIVES**

Mr. Hall provided the Board with information on the Department's current Healthiest Weight Initiative and inquired of the Board regarding several questions the Department established. The Board's responses were as follows:

- The Board would like to receive quarterly emails and handouts regarding the Healthiest Weight Initiative.
- The Board agreed with the suggestion that the Department's delegated representative should present at the FOTA meeting, but did not agree a booth would be necessary or likely beneficial.

Ms. Roeck-Simmons questioned approval to distribute the Healthy Weight brochure and information to clinicians, in which Mr. Hall assured, was permissible and encouraged and informed the Board the initiative materials for distribution are available on the Department's Healthy Weight Initiative webpage.
