DETERMINATION OF WAIVER

TAB 1 Rosina Elvira Levy, DOH Case No. 2014-13099, OT 3208, File #3035
(PCP – Johnson, Hicks)

Rosina Elvira Levy, Respondent, was not present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: Section 456.072(1)(kk), Florida Statutes (2014) by being terminated for cause, from the state Medicaid program pursuant to Section 409.913, Florida Statutes.

MOTION: Ms. McKenzie made a motion that the Respondent was properly served and waived her right to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Spafford made a motion to adopt all materials and addendums into evidence in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Spafford made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Spafford made a motion to adopt the conclusions of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/4 vote.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Spafford made a motion to impose the following penalties:

- Reprimand
- \$1,000 Fine to be paid within 90 days of the date of the filing of the final order

VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT

TAB 2 Sarah Jeanette Del Sasso, DOH Case No. 2015-01489, OTA 11010, File #3924

Sarah Jeanette Del Sasso, Respondent, was not present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board. Respondent charged with the following violations: Section 456.072(1)(c)(k)(x)(z)(dd)(hh), Florida Statutes. Section 468.217(1)(c)(h)(q)(t)(x) Florida Statutes and pursuant to 456.074(3) Florida Statutes by failing to maintain acceptable standards for occupational therapy. The Respondent waived probable cause in lieu of undergoing further disciplinary proceedings and returned an executed Voluntary Relinquishment of her license, agreeing to never apply for licensure as an occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant in the state of Florida, again.

TAB 5 Abigail Katherine Hooper, File # 7600, OTA by Examination

Ms. Hooper was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Hooper's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application. Ms. Hooper has passed the NBCOT examination.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to approve Ms. Hooper's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

TAB 6 James Douglas Melton, File # 7614, OTA by Examination

Mr. Melton, was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Mr. Melton's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to his affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application. Mr. Melton has passed the NBCOT examination.

MOTION: After discussion Ms. Watson made a motion to approve Mr. Melton's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

TAB 7 Mackenzie Piatz, File # 16824, OT by Initial Endorsement

Ms. Piatz, was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Piatz's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to approve Ms. Piatz's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried with a 4/0 vote.

TAB 8 Roger Salazar, File # 7115, OTA by Initial Examination

Mr. Salazar was not present and not represented by legal counsel.

Mr. Salazar's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to his affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application. Mr. Salazar was noticed of the potential denial of his application under Section 456.0635, Florida Statutes, which defines offenses that are prohibitive to licensure until a certain timeframe has passed.

Prior to the Board meeting, Mr. Salazar notified the Board office he would not be in attendance and submitted a letter requesting that the Board allow for the withdrawal of his application in the event the discussion was moving towards denial of his application. It was determined by the Board that Mr. Salazar was indeed ineligible for licensure under this section and could not be considered for licensure until DATE 2020, due to the specific offenses reported.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. McKenzie made a motion to accept the withdrawal of Mr. Salazar's application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

EXEMPTION APPLICATION

TAB 23 Kimberly Dawn Smith, OT 16728, File 16178

Ms. Smith was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Smith submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care setting.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Roeck-Simmons made a motion to **grant** Ms. Smith's exemption for disqualification from employment. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

APPLICANT RATIFICATION LISTS

TAB 9 Endorsement Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve the Endorsement ratification list of 113 applicants for licensure (APPENDIX 1), including an Addendum list of 79 applicants (APPENDIX 2), totaling 192 names. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried with a 4/0 vote.

ACTION TAKEN: 192 names ratified for licensure by endorsement.

TAB 10 Examination Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve for licensure, pending the successful passage of the NBCOT examination, Exam ratification list of applicants for 142 names (APPENDIX 3), including an Addendum list of 36 applicants (APPENDIX 4), totaling 178 names. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

ACTION TAKEN: 178 names ratified for licensure pending successful exam results.

TAB 11 Examination with Waiver Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve the Examination with Waiver ratification list of 6 applicants for licensure (APPENDIX 5), including an Addendum list of 2 name (APPENDIX 6), totaling 8 names. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

ACTION TAKEN: 8 names ratified for licensure by Examination with Waiver.

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to approve 5 continuing education providers, and 1 Prevention of Medical Errors course provider, and 1 Laws and Rules course provider. (APPENDIX 7), including an Addendum list of 3 continuing education providers, and 1 American Occupational Therapy Association provider approved by Board Rule. (APPENDIX 8),: 8 continuing education provider applications, 1 Prevention of Medical Errors course provider and 1 Laws and Rules course provider and 1 American Occupational Therapy Association provider approved. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried with a 4/0 vote.

Consideration of NBCOT Options for Florida Licensees
Shaun Conway, Director of NBCOT Credentialing Services

TAB 13 NBCOT PRESENTATION

Consideration of NBCOT Options for Florida Licensees - Shaun Conway, Director of NBCOT Credentialing Services

Mr. Shaun Conway, Credentialing Services Director for the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT), requested the Board's consideration in implementing several options for Florida licensees. The Board's discussion and determinations are as summarized below.

- **Use of NBCOT Navigator™ Professional Development Tools towards fulfillment of Florida's CE Requirements for OT/OTA Licensure Renewal;**

After discussion, the Board determined that licensees may obtain continuing education credit for this professional development tool under the Board's existing continuing education Rule 64B11-6.001(5), F.A.C., pertaining to completion of courses relevant to the practice of occupational therapy. Under this provision, licensees are able to self-submit certificates of completion to Florida's required mandatory reporting system, CE Broker. It was clarified that because these tools do not involve real-time interaction with a course instructor, these credits would be considered home study. Licensees are limited to a maximum of 12 hours of home study continuing education credits per licensure biennium.

- **Use of Current NBCOT Certification towards fulfillment of Florida's CE Requirements for OT/OTA Licensure Renewal; and**

Mr. Conway also requested the Board's recognition of NBCOT certification renewal as an option for meeting/fulfilling the state's continuing education requirements. The Board discussed this option but determined not to initiate rulemaking to implement this proposal.

The Board also discussed the option for NBCOT to apply to become a Florida CE Provider, if desired. Approval as a provider would allow for marketing and advertisement of the organization's CE competency tools to licensees through CE Broker. Staff agreed to provide Mr. Conway with information regarding becoming a CE Provider.

- **Official Recognition of Florida's Use of the NBCOT Online Verification of Certification Service for Licensure Application Processing**

Mr. Conway's last request to the Board was for recognition of NBCOT's online Verification of Certification service, as a primary source verification, which could be relied upon for processing all occupational therapy license applications in Florida.

The Board staff acknowledged that this online verification service is currently utilized in the processing of Endorsement and Exam with Waiver applications. Both methods require verification of the NBCOT certification status of applicants. Prior to the availability of the online service, verifications were provided in hard copy by regular mail, which often resulted in lengthier timeframes for applicants to complete the requirements for issuance of a license.

TAB 14 RULES REVIEW AND OR DEVELOPMENT *(And any other rules as may be necessary)*

Following the Annual Rules Review, Board Counsel presented to repeal the following rules because they are essentially the same as the statutory language in Chapter 468.209, Florida Statutes.

Rule 64B11-2.005, F.A.C., Temporary Permit to Practice Occupational Therapy

Rule 64B11-3.003, F.A.C., Temporary Permit to Practice as an Occupational Therapy Assistant

MOTION: Ms. Watson made a motion to repeal the rules as proposed. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion that the rule repeals will not have an adverse impact on small business, and are not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

TAB 15 RULES REVIEW AND OR DEVELOPMENT

Board Counsel presented for the Board's consideration the following enclosed proposed rule repeals for discussion.

Rule 64B11-5.005, F.A.C., Unlicensed Activity Fee

Board Counsel proposed repeal of rule because it is essentially the same as the statutory language in Chapter 456.065, Florida Statutes.

MOTION: Ms. Watson made a motion to repeal the rule as proposed. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion that the rule repeal will not have an adverse impact on small business, and are not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

TAB 16 Rule 64B11-5.001 F.A.C., (15) Performance of Pro Bono Services

During the February 23, 2015 Board meeting, the Board considered its first request for approval of pro-bono services for continuing education credit. Although the request was approved within the parameters of the current rule, there were questions regarding the limit of hours as well as when a licensee is required to seek approval for credit. The Board requested that this item be placed on the next agenda for further discussion.

At the May 18, 2015 meeting the Board discussed rule revisions and agreed for Board Counsel to bring back proposed language at the August 10, 2015 meeting for the Boards review, to follow with noticing of Rule Development.

Board Counsel presented the following proposed Rule language for the Board review:

64B11-5.001 Requirements for License Renewal of an Active License; Continuing Education.

(15) Performance of Pro Bono Services – A licensee may receive up to six (6) ~~four (4)~~ hours per biennium of continuing education credit through the performance of pro bono services to the indigent as provided in Section 456.013(9), F.S., or to underserved populations, or in areas of critical need within the state where the licensee practices. In order to receive credit under this rule, licensees must make a written request ~~application~~ to the Board and receive approval in advance. One (1) hour credit shall be given for each two (2) hours worked. In the written request, ~~application for approval~~, licensees shall disclose the type, nature and extent of services to be rendered, the facility where the services will be rendered, the number of patients expected to be serviced, and a statement indicating that the patients

to be served are indigent. If the licensee intends to provide services in underserved or critical need areas, the written request ~~application~~ shall provide a brief explanation as to those facts.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion that the proposed rule revision will not have an adverse impact on small business, and is not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.
