**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

**TAB 1 Michelle Nicole Perry Burkhard, DOH Case No.2015-05111, OTA 9958, File #2824 Settlement Agreement, (PCP Members - Johnson and McKenzie)**

Ms. McKenzie was recused from this case due to her participation on the Probable Cause Panel.

Michelle Nicole Perry Burkhard, Respondent, was not present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation: Sections: 468.217(1)(x) and 456.072(1)(aa) Florida Statutes (2013). This is a one count Administrative Complaint which alleges that Respondent tested positive on a pre-employment drug screening in violation of the Florida Statutes. Respondent tested positive for methadone and marijuana on a pre-employment drug screening on or about March 17, 2014.

In response to this complaint, Respondent has submitted several letters of recommendation and her explanation of what occurred. Respondent does not dispute the issues of material fact alleged in the Administrative Complaint, but wants to resolve this situation and therefore has agreed to enter into a Settlement Agreement with the Department.

#### Disciplinary Guidelines:

Section 468.217(1)(x), F.S., Suspension until law or rule complied with and \$500 fine. Section 456.072(1)(aa), F.S., no specific guidelines.

Reprimand

Reimbursement of Costs

#### **TAB 2 Duanda Clark, DOH Case No.2015-07023, OT 15275 File #14865 Settlement Agreement, (PCP Members - Johnson and McKenzie)**

Ms. McKenzie was recused from this case due to her participation on the Probable Cause Panel.

Duanda Clark, Respondent, was present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McNulty requested and Ms. Clark agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violations: Section: 468.217(1)(i), Florida Statutes (2014). This is a one count Administrative Complaint which alleges that Respondent knowingly filed a false report in her capacity as an occupational therapist. For approximately one month, Respondent submitted treatment notes for a patient when she did not in fact treat the patient for all of the dates as indicated.

#### Disciplinary Guidelines:

Section 468.217(1)(i), Florida Statutes: From one (1) year probation with conditions and a fine of \$100 to six (6) months' suspension, one (1) year probation with conditions, and a fine of \$250.

Respondent does not dispute the allegations and has agreed to enter into this settlement agreement. Respondent agrees to be supervised for a period of one year to ensure that this conduct does not occur again. The terms of the settlement agreement are within the disciplinary guidelines for such an offense and probation will appropriately address the underlying conduct.

#### Terms of Settlement Agreement

- Fine (\$2,000.00) to be paid within 3 years

- 1 Year Probation

#### **TAB 5            Kristen Laura Cuneo, OTA by Exam, File #7950**

Ms. Cuneo was present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McNulty requested, and Ms. Cuneo agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Ms. Cuneo's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve Ms. Cuneo's application for licensure, pending proof of successful NBCOT exam results. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 6 Heather Rae Dietz, OT by Exam with Waiver, File # 16978**

Ms. Dietz was present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Dietz's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

Ms. McNulty requested, and Ms. Dietz agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Additional to Ms. Dietz's history review, Board staff determined Ms. Dietz's application is currently ineligible for licensure under the Exam with Waiver application method, which requires an active license in another state or jurisdiction. Ms. Dietz has held a CA and VA license, however, both are expired. Ms. Dietz must submit proof of current licensure in another state; or change her application method to Endorsement and submit proof of a renewed, current NBCOT certification. Ms. Dietz agreed to a 90 day waiver for further processing of her application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to require a PRN evaluation to be completed within 6 months, and delegated authority to the Board Chair to review the PRN evaluation when received, to decide upon licensure or further Board review. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 7 Arantxa Perez Mata Grajales, OT by Endorsement, File #16952**

Ms. Arantxa Perez Mata Grajales was present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McNulty requested and Ms. Grajales agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Ms. Grajales's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to approve Ms. Grajales' application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 8 Jeremiah Daniel Klotz, OT by Endorsement, File #16964**

Mr. Klotz, was present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McNulty requested and Mr. Klotz agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings. Mr. Klotz's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to submitting fraudulent documentation to receive a temporary permit, and current NBCOT disciplinary sanctions against him.

Ms. McNulty advised the Board of the statues regarding possible grounds for condition or denial of a license are as follows under 456.0712(1)(h), Florida Statutes says attempting to attain or renewing a

license in a profession by bribery, by fraudulent misrepresentation through an error, by the DEPT or the Board, the disciplinary guidelines call for either Revocation, with an ability to reapply with a \$1000 to a \$3,000 fine. However, if the violations are not through an error by the Board, but by making a false misrepresentation the fine may be increased up to a \$10,000 fine. Ms. McNulty further explained to the Board their options include, they could deny Mr. Klotz's application for licensure, or allow Mr. Klotz to withdraw his application to avoid a denial on record. Mr. Klotz did submit fraudulent documentation to obtain a Temporary permit.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve Mr. Klotz for licensure with conditions. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote. The conditions set by the Board regarding violation of 456.072(l)(h), Florida Statutes are as follows:

- \$10,000 fine payable within 5 years, to be paid equally \$2,000 each year
- 5 years of probation to include
  - 3 years of direct supervision (on the premises)
  - 2 years of indirect supervision (within 20 miles and available by phone)
  - Including tolling provisions; anytime the applicant is not employed the time is tolled
- Monitor/Supervisor must be a Florida licensed OT, PT or SPLA, not assistants, and resumes must be submitted to the Board Chair for review and approval, prior to the issuance of a license.
- Quarterly reports from the Mr. Klotz and the Monitor/Supervisor are required to include billing, medical and administrative compliance reviews
  - 50% of patients records review for 3 years while under direct supervision
  - 25% of patients records review for 2 years while under indirect supervision
- First and last appearances required before the Board, with the Monitor/Supervisor, prior to termination, and any other time the Board may require.

Appearing with, and spoke to the Board on behalf of Mr. Klotz, was Mr. Klotz's girlfriend, Ms. Tonya Trussel the Assistant Director of Nursing at Mr. Klotz's place of employment.

## **TAB 9            Elizabeth Ann Townsend, OTA by Exam, File #7916**

Ms. Townsend, was present and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McNulty requested and Ms. Townsend agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Ms. Townsend's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to approve Ms. Townsend's application for licensure, pending proof of successful NBCOT exam results. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 10            Patrycja A. Zaleska, OTA by Exam, File # 7887**

Ms. McNulty requested and Mr. Sanford and Ms. Kaysan agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Mr. Sanford was scheduled for a final appearance with his Monitor/Supervisor commencing termination of his probation.

Mr. Sanford thanked the Board for his second chance and stated he has learned a lot. Mr. Hicks requested the Monitor to speak. Ms. Kaysan stated Mr. Sanford is a very good skilled therapist and his clients appreciate his services, and that he treats with skill and care. Ms. Kaysan concluded Mr. Sanford's evaluations are great, and his notes and documentation consistently all match with the billable.

Mr. Hicks moved to accept Mr. Sanford's final appearance and completion of his probation terms. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

The Board thanked Ms. Kaysan for her services as a monitor for the Board.

Ms. McNulty requested and Ms. Suma agreed to be truthful to the Board in the proceedings.

Ms. Suma's application was presented to the Board as an Individual Consideration due to her affirmative response to a criminal history question on the application.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve Ms. Suma's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve the Endorsement ratification list of 126 applicants for licensure (APPENDIX 1), including an Addendum list of 33 applicants (APPENDIX 2), totaling 159 names. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**ACTION TAKEN:** 159 names ratified for licensure by endorsement.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve the Examination with Waiver ratification list of 5 applicants for licensure (APPENDIX 5), including an Addendum list of 1 name (APPENDIX 6), totaling 6 names. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**ACTION TAKEN:** 6 names ratified for licensure by Examination with Waiver.

## **TAB 14 Continuing Education Provider Applications**

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve 5 continuing education providers, and 3 Prevention of Medical Errors course provider, and 2 American Occupational Therapy Association providers approved by Board Rule, (APPENDIX 7), including an Addendum list of 1 continuing education provider, 1 Prevention of Medical Errors course provider. Ms. McNulty requested that TABS 16-18 be reviewed together.

Mr. Hall explained to the Board in regards to the Governor and the state's Surgeon General recommendation to reduce unnecessary language in the Board Rules as much as possible, Ms. McNulty and Mr. Hicks have worked together with Board staff to consolidate several rules in Rule 64B11 Chapters 2 and 3. The rule language in these chapters are repetitive for occupational therapist

and occupational therapy assistants, therefore there were no substantive differences, allowing the rules to be easily consolidated. The list of Rules repealed include:

- 64B11-3.001 Fees; Application.
- 64B11-3.0021 Application by Endorsement.
- 64B11-3.004 Examination; Passing Grade.
- 64B11-3.005 Medical Error Prevention Education for Initial Licensure.
- 64B11-3.006 Fee; Initial License.
- 64B11-3.007 Fees; Renewal of License
- 64B11-3.008 Duplicate License Fee.
- 64B11-3.009 Applicants Seeking Reentry.
- 64B11-3.010 Definition of Supervised Fieldwork Experience.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to accept the rule language for Consolidation of Rules under Tabs, 16, 17 and 18 as proposed, in respect to the identified rules in Rules 64B11, Chapters 2 and 3. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** After discussion Mr. Hicks made a motion that the Board agreed the Rule amendments will not have an adverse impact on small business, and is not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida, within 1 year after the implementation of the rule, as the rules are simply being consolidated. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **TAB 19            OT/OTA Application: DH-MQA, Rules 64B11-2.003 FA.C.**

Ms. King instructed the Board regarding staffs revision of the current paper OT/OTA application in an effort to minimize and consolidate the instructions for clarity, and to simplify the process for prospective applicants.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve the proposed modifications to Rule 64B11-2.003, FA.C. and the OT/OTA application as presented. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion that the Rule amendments will not have an adverse impact on small business, and is not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida, within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 4/0 vote.

Mr. Larry Gonzalez, Esq, FOTA, commended his appreciation to the Board and the Attorney General's Office staff for the work in eliminating unnecessary rule language regarding the rules consolidations.
