**TAB 2            Anthony Fain, DOH Case No.2015-02992, OTA 9844, File #2693  
(PCP Members - Johnson and McKenzie)**

Anthony Fain, Respondent, was not present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. McKenzie was recused in this case due to her previous participation on the Probable Cause Panel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board. Respondent was charged with the following violation Section 456.072(1)(II) Florida Statutes (2014). The Administrative Complaint alleged Respondent pled guilty to a crime related to healthcare fraud. On July 17, 2014, Respondent pled guilty to Conspiracy to commit Healthcare Fraud. By doing so, Respondent admitted that from in or around July 2011 and continuing through at least about May 2013, Respondent conspired with others to defraud Medicare

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Program by falsely certifying services he did not provide, thereby causing the submission of false and fraudulent claims to the Medicare Program seeking payment for services not rendered to Medicare beneficiaries. As the penalty for, the Department recommends revocation as stated in the disciplinary guidelines regarding a Healthcare fraud conviction.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to find the Respondent was properly served and requested an informal hearing. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the materials in Tab 2 and any addendums into evidence in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 3/0 vote.

### **PETITION FOR VARIANCE OR WAIVER IN REVIEW OF LICENSURE APPLICATION**

#### **TAB 6          Tobi Gilbert, Rule 64B11-2.012 Applicants Seeking Reentry, File #17336**

Ms. Gilbert was not present, and not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilbert submitted a Petition for Waiver Pursuant to Rule 64B11-2.012, F.A.C., Applicants Seeking Reentry and continuing education hours to comply with the 50-hour continuing education requirement for re-entry applicants, in support of her endorsement application for licensure.

Pursuant to *Rule 64B11-2.012, F.A.C., Applicants Seeking Reentry*, occupational therapy professionals who have not been in active practice for the last 5 years must complete 50 hours of occupational therapy continuing education hours, 12 of which may be home study, taken within the year prior to licensure, in order to proceed with the licensure process.

Ms. Gilbert has held an active license to practice occupational therapy in Texas since 1998, however, indicated that in the past 5 years her employment was more administrative than clinical. Because neither the applicable Florida OT law nor statute defines “active” practice, staff was unable to advise her with regard to how the rule applied to her particular scenario. Ultimately, upon submission of the application, Ms. Gilbert determined to answer “No”, indicating she had not been in active practice for the last 5 years.

Ms. Gilbert submitted over 50 hours of continuing education taken to maintain her OT license in Texas. For the Board’s consideration, Ms. Gilbert filed a Petition for Waiver of the portions of the Florida re-entry rule which limits the number of home study hours to twelve (12) and requires the continuing education hours to have been completed “within one year prior to licensure”.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Mr. Spafford made a motion to grant Ms. Gilbert’s Petition for Waiver Pursuant to Rule 64B11-2.012, F.A.C., Applicants Seeking Reentry, and approve Ms. Gilbert’s submitted continuing education for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 3/1 vote.

**MOTION:** Following, Mr. Spafford made a motion to approve Ms. Gilbert’s application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. McKenzie and carried with a 4/0 vote.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

**TAB 19 Board Conviction Records Guidelines Florida Board of Occupational Therapy Practice**

Board staff requested Ms. McNulty to review and revise the Conviction Record Guidelines that assist staff in determining which items should automatically be referred for the Chair or Board's consideration and those which staff may clear for legal clarity. After Ms. McNulty's review, such was submitted to the Board for review and approval.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve the revised Conviction Record Guidelines as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**TAB 20 2016 Legislative Update**

Mr. Hall provided the Board with a 2016 legislative update including the draft language for bills that passed the House and Senate that potentially affected the profession during the 2016 session.

- SB 1150 and HB 953 - related to rulemaking authority and did not pass.
- CS/CS/HB7087 - Telehealth, bill language provided, passed.
- HB 981 - related to Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC). Bill language provided, passed.
- CS/CS/HB 941 - Department of Health. Bill language and specifics provided in a separate tab, passed.

**TAB 21 CS/CS/HB 941 – Department of Health**

Mr. Hall provided for the Board in this tab a continuation of the bills that passed in the legislative session that directly impacted the OT Board including those requiring Rule revisions.

**456.013(7) – Medical errors CE no longer required at initial licensure. Medical errors CE will only be required at renewal.**

The rules necessitating amendments include the following:

- Rule 64B11-2.003 Fees; Application
- Rule 64B11-2.007 Medical Error Prevention Education for initial licensure License

**456.024 – Multiple changes related to expedited licensure for Members of the United States Armed Forces and their spouses.**

No rule changes were required to implement this provision.

**456.0361 – Electronic continuing education tracking system. Department may not renew a license until a licensee complies with all applicable CE requirements.**

No rule changes were required to implement this provision.

**456.057 – Allows the Department to contract with a third party to be the custodian of medical records in the event of the death of a practitioner, the mental or physical incapacitation of a practitioner or the abandonment of medical records by a practitioner.**

No rule changes were required to implement this provision.

**456.0635 – Applicants with a 456.0635 conviction (certain drug and fraud convictions) will no longer have an exemption when they were enrolled in an educational training program on or before July 1, 2009.**

The application had to be updated to delete the reference to this exemption.

**ADDENDUM - TAB 21 CS/CS/HB 941 – Department of Health**

Additionally included in an addendum, staff provided updated rule language and a revised application form with a July 2016 revision date, as the law requires proposed changes will not go into effect until July 1<sup>st</sup>, proposing adding back the ability for applicants to list their “Date of Birth” as *optional*, as it appears the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) is willing to consider allowing it to be listed as such on the application form. It is beneficial to applicants to record this information with the Department for purposes of identification and access to MQA online services through a secure account.

\*\* At this time, the Board tabled the current discussion for Board Staff to retrieve further information regarding the application revisions and the agenda moved on to TAB 22.

licensure with revisions as indicated by Ms. McNulty in discussion on Question 6 on the application form, including the additional modifications to implement HB 941, repealing the Medical Error requirement, removing reference to the educational exemption, and including the optional DOB; and directed Ms. McNulty to proceed with the rulemaking process. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** After Board discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion that neither of these Rule amendments will have an adverse impact on small business, and is not likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida, within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Spafford made a motion that neither of the Rule amendments will have any significant anti-competitive impacts. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 4/0 vote.
