7 **PROSECUTOR'S REPORT**

8 **TAB 1 Manshi Shah, Prosecuting Attorney**

9 Ms. Shah submitted the Prosecutor's Report outlining the current open disciplinary cases.

10 **TAB 5 Wendy Blackstone, OTA 3760 (Tab 7 of April 9, 2012GBM Agenda)**

1 **Exemption from Disqualification of Employment Application**

2 Ms. Blackstone was present on the conference call for the meeting and was represented by counsel,
3 Ms. Barbara Kornblau.

4 Ms. Blackstone has been a Florida licensed Occupational Therapy Assistant since October 8, 1993.
5 Ms. Blackstone has previous charges reflected in her AHCA Background Level II Screening which
6 resulted in her disqualification from employment in AHCA facilities. Ms. Blackstone submitted an
7 application for Exemption from Disqualification of employment in a health care setting for the OT
8 Board's review.

9 The stated charges prompting Ms. Blackstone's request for an exemption were Misdemeanor
10 charges committed in 2000 after Ms. Blackstone's original date of licensure in 1993. Ms. Blackstone
11 submitted proof of completing all court requirements and stated the incident was a one time
12 occurrence. There are no records indicating Ms. Blackstone reported such information to the Board,
13 and Ms. Kornblau explained, Ms. Blackstone did not understand the obligations, but has since taken
14 a Florida laws and rules CE course and understands such obligations of licensees.

15 **MOTION:** Following discussion, Ms. Garcia made a motion to approve Ms. Blackstone's exemption.
16 Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

17 **POST- DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

18 **TAB 2 Steven Sanford, Case #2066-14494 (Tab 5 of April 9, 2012 GBM Agenda)**

19 Mr. Sanford was not present on the conference call for the meeting.

20 Mr. Sanford's quarterly compliance reports were submitted on the agenda due to the Board's
21 previous requests. Ms. King stated she spoke this morning with Ms. Footman, the Compliance
22 Officer, who stated Mr. Sanford is currently out of compliance with his Final Order, due to having not
23 received his quarterly report by the required date of May 13, 2012.

24 Ms. King requested since the Board issued a revised and more detailed Final Order to Mr. Sanford at
25 the January 9, 2012 meeting, to allow Ms. Footman to manage this case rather than submitting Mr.
26 Sanford's compliance reports on each Board agenda. Ms. Footman indicated with the clarity of the
27 newly revised final order she was confident in managing Mr. Sanford's compliance case and would
28 provide feed back when necessary to the Board.

29 **MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion for the compliance officer to manage this case without
30 continuing to submit reports to the Board on each agenda. Ms Garcia seconded the motion, which
31 carried 4/0.

32 **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

33 **PERSONAL APPEARANCE**

34 **TAB 3 Derek Smaczniak, OT by Endorsement, file #14485**

35 Mr. Smaczniak was present on the conference call for the meeting.

1 Mr. Smaczniak's application file for licensure as an Occupational Therapist was presented to the
2 Board for review due to previous Driving While Impaired charges in 2001 and 2006. At the January
3 9, 2012 Board meeting, Mr. Smaczniak was not present, and because the Board needed additional
4 information to make an appropriate decision regarding his licensure, the Board requested Mr.
5 Smaczniak to make a Personal Appearance. The Board additionally suggested submission of the
6 following supplementary documentation to support Mr. Smaczniak's application:
7

- 8 • Recommendation letters from previous employers and/or co-professionals.
- 9 • Proof of sobriety/rehabilitation, such as an evaluative letter from therapist, sponsor or Doctor.
- 10 • Information regarding past/previous employment history and/or possible volunteer work, or
clinical evaluations from school professors or clinical supervisors.

11 Mr. Smaczniak was advised of such recommendations, but submitted no additional documentation.

12 **MOTION:** Following discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion to request Mr. Smaczniak to complete a
13 PRN evaluation prior to the next scheduled Board meeting. The review of this evaluation will be
14 delegated to the Board Chair. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

15 Mr. Smaczniak received instructions from Mr. Hall and Board Counsel, regarding application
16 processing, review and approval by the Board requirements, and verbally agreed to waive the 90 day
17 review requirement of his application. Mr. Smaczniak additionally agreed to follow-up with submitting
18 a written statement by email to the Board

19 **EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS**

20 **TAB 4 Alex Louis Balsley, OTA 9476 (Tab 6 of April 9, 2012 GBM Agenda)** 21 **Exemption from Disqualification of Employment Application**

22 Mr. Balsley was not present on the conference call for the meeting.

23 Mr. Balsley has been a Florida licensed Occupational Therapy Assistant since 11/03/00. Mr. Balsley
24 has previous charges reflected in his AHCA Background Level II Screening which resulted in his
25 disqualification from employment in AHCA facilities. Mr. Balsley submitted an application for
26 Exemption from Disqualification of Employment in a health care setting for the OT Board's review on
27 January 27, 2012. Mr. Balsley was previously approved by the Board for an exemption in February
28 2003 based on an AHCA Background Level I Screening.

29 The stated charges prompting Mr. Balsley's request for an exemption were committed prior to Mr.
30 Balsley's original date of licensure. Mr. Balsley stated he has had no other charges since his first
31 exemption was approved in his initial personal statement and such was confirmed by Mr. Balsley's
32 background screening information.

33 **MOTION:** Ms. Banta made a motion to approve Mr. Balsley's exemption. Ms. Garcia seconded the
34 motion, which carried 4/0.

35 **TAB 6 Jeanne Lee, OTA 351 (Tab 8 of April 9, 2012 GBM Agenda)** 36 **Exemption from Disqualification of Employment Application**

37 Ms. Lee was present on the conference call for the meeting.
38 Ms. Lee has been a Florida licensed Occupational Therapy Assistant since 08/15/1988. Ms. Lee has
39 previous charges reflected in her AHCA Background Level II Screening which resulted in her

1 disqualification from employment in AHCA facilities. Ms. Lee submitted an application for Exemption
2 from Disqualification of employment in a health care setting for the OT Board's review. The stated
3 charges prompting Ms. Lee's request for an exemption were committed prior to Ms. Lee's original
4 date of licensure, and she did not disclose such information on her original application for licensure.
5 Ms. Lee stated she has had no additional charges since this incident in her personal statement and
6 such was confirmed by Ms. Lee's background screening information.

7 **MOTION:** Following discussion, Ms. Banta made a motion to approve Ms. Lee's exemption. Ms.
8 Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

9 **APPLICANT RATIFICATION LISTS**

10 **TAB 7 Endorsement Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants (Tab 9 of April** 11 **9, 2012 Agenda)**

12 **MOTION:** Ms. Banta moved to approve the ratification list of applicants for licensure, 107 names,
13 including 35 names on an addendum list, totaling 142 names. Ms. Garcia seconded the motion,
14 which carried 4/0.

15 **ACTION TAKEN:** 142 names ratified for licensure by endorsement.

16 **TAB 8 Examination Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants (Tab 10 of April** 17 **9, 2012 Agenda)**

18 **MOTION:** Ms. Banta moved to approve for licensure, pending the successful passage of the NBCOT
19 examination, ratification list of applicants for licensure as noted, 176 names, including 11 names on
20 an addendum list, totaling 187 names. Ms. Garcia seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

21 **ACTION TAKEN:** 186 names approved for licensure pending successful exam results.

24 **MOTION:** Ms. Banta moved to approve the list of 5 applicants for licensure, by Examination with

28 **MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve the 3 continuing education providers as listed for
29 ratification, including 1 provider on an addendum list. Including 3 providers offering Prevention of
30 Medical Errors courses, and 1 course on the addendum list. There were no providers offering Laws
31 and Rules courses at this time. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

32 **ACTION TAKEN:** 4 continuing education providers approved and 4 Prevention of Medical Error

6 annual regulatory plan that shall identify and describe each rule that the agency expects to begin
7 promulgating during the next twelve-month period.”

38 this license?” The Board discussed and agreed for Board staff to work with Counsel to provide
39 revised language for this question acceptable to JAPC.

7 Mr. Hall presented the standard agenda budget reports for the Board's review.

8 Mr. Hall gave the Board the following brief summary of the 2012 legislation session regarding the bills
9 passed with an effect on the Board of OT.

10 HB 653 (2012) modifies s. 456.0635, F.S., revising the grounds under which DOH or corresponding
11 boards are required to refuse to admit a candidate to an examination and refuse to issue or renew a
12 license, certificate, or registration of a health care practitioner. These changes require all MQA
13 Boards and Councils are to update their licensure applications to include revised 456.0635 History
14 questions in accordance with these modifications. The Department is currently working with the State
15 Attorney's office to complete the new language revisions.

16 HB1263 relates to reorganizing the Department of Health, including one aspect of the Bill that
17 specifically requires the MQA Division to report how the Boards can improve and speed up the
18 licensure process, as well as improve certain Board and office functions. Mr. Hall stated the
19 Department is working on the development of this task and will be requesting input from the Boards
20 to provide these reports to the Legislature.

8 **TAB 21 Delegation of Authority, RE: Exemption Applications**

9 Board Staff requested the Board to delegate authority to the Board Chair to approve level 2
10 employment exemptions for licensees who hold a level 1 exemption approved by the Board when no
11 additional criminal charges have occurred. This process would afford the licensee to be re-employed
12 more promptly, verses waiting for the next scheduled Board meeting for review.

- 13 1. Board office receives application for exemption from OT/OTA licensee.
- 14 2. Board staff researches whether a Level I has been previously been granted.
- 15 3. Board staff requests from licensee (if not provided) a copy of the AHCA letter received
16 indicating the disqualifying offense.
- 17 4. Board staff (RSII Team Lead or POA) requests background screening report from AHCA.
- 18 5. Board staff reviews to verify that there have been no additional criminal charges found on the
19 screening report since the Level I was granted.
- 20 6. If no additional criminal charges, Board staff submits a summary of the facts and the
21 exemption application to the Board Chair for review and approval.
- 22 7. If there are additional criminal charges revealed, Board staff prepares the application for
23 review by the full Board.

24 The following language added to the Delegation of Authority list:

25 Authority to approve level 2 employment exemption for licensees who held a level 1 exemption
26 approved by the Board when no additional criminal charges are present. Our process would be
27 carried out as follows:
