**DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS**

**MOTION FOR VOLUNTARY RELINQUISHMENT OF LICENSE**

**TAB 1 Theresa Rene Pantaella, OT 2000, Case # 2012-10669**

Ms. Pantaella was not present for the meeting nor represented by counsel.

Ms. Shah summarized the case for the Board, stating Probable Cause was waived by the licensee. Ms. Pantaella practiced occupational therapy at Quality Rehab Systems, Inc., which was located in Broward and Palm Beach Counties, Florida. Quality Rehab Systems, Inc billed the Medicare program for occupational therapy services, which included aquatic exercises, purportedly provided to patients.

In addition to practicing occupational therapy at Quality Rehab Systems, Inc, Ms. Pantaella was the president and owner of Quality Rehab Systems, Inc. From in or around 2008, to in or around November 2010, Ms. Pantaella was submitting fraudulent claim forms to Medicare. On or about December 27, 2011, Ms. Pantaella was charged with one count of health care fraud, in violation of 18 United States Code §1347 and 2, in a felony Indictment, which was filed in the United States District Court Southern District of Florida, in case number 11-60300-CR-DIMITROULEASE/SNOW. On or about April 20, 2012, Ms. Pantaella entered a plea of guilty to one count of health care fraud, in violation of 18 United States Code §1347 and 2, in the United States District Court Southern District of Florida, in case number 11-60300-CR-DIMITROULEASE/SNOW. On or about July 27, 2012, Ms. Pantaella was sentenced to, among other things, eighteen (18) months of imprisonment and ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$586,369.00.

In response to the allegations, Ms. Pantaella signed a Voluntary Relinquishment. The Department requests the Board accept the Voluntary Relinquishment.

Ms. Pantaella's purpose in executing this Voluntary Relinquishment is to avoid further administrative action with respect to these causes. Ms. Pantaella understands that acceptance of this Voluntary Relinquishment by the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice is considered as disciplinary action against her OT license, and agrees to never reapply for licensure as an occupational therapist or an occupational therapy assistant in the state of Florida.

**MOTION:** Mr. Mullings made a motion to accept the Voluntary Relinquishment. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and passed with a 4/0 vote.

#### **MOTION OF DETERMINATION OF WAIVER**

**TAB 2            Andrea Jane Trim, OTA 10212, Case # 2012-03389  
(PCP – Johnson, Mullings)**

Mr. Mullings was recused due to participation in the Probable Cause Panel

Ms. Trim was not present for the meeting nor represented by counsel.

Ms. Shah summarized the case for the Board. Ms. Trim renewed her occupational therapy assistant license. A random continuing education audit for occupational therapist and occupational therapy assistants was completed for the licensure biennial renewal period of March 1, 2009 through February 28, 2011. Ms. Trim failed to provide proof of completing 18 hours of general education and 2 hours of Prevention of Medical Errors education. On November 15, 2011 Ms. Trim was issued a citation 2011-18068 for failing to submit proof of completion of the required continuing education. Pursuant to the filed Citation, Ms. Trim was required to complete 4 hours of prevention of medical errors education, and 36 hours of general continuing education, submit a fine of \$1000 and \$112 costs, totaling \$ 1,122 due by March 2, 2012. As of May 30, 2012, Ms. Trim had neither paid the fines nor failed to submit proof of the continuing education requirements, nor has Ms. Trim responded to the Department's correspondence. A copy of the Administrative Complaint, Explanation of Rights, and Election of Rights forms were sent to Ms. Trim's address of record, and/or last known address, via certified US mail delivery and were returned to the Department as "unclaimed". After performing a diligent search, on August 18, 2012, the Department served via certified mail the Administrative Complaint, Election of Rights, Explanation of Rights, and Settlement Agreement to Ms. Trim at 3127 Hoehn St. NW, Grand Rapids, MI 49504. Ms. Trim has neither filed with the Department of Health nor the Board of Occupational Therapy Practice an Election of Rights form or other responsive pleading in this case within the twenty-one day period to dispute the allegations of fact contained in the Administrative Complaint. Ms. Trim has been advised by this motion a copy of the investigative file in this case shall

be furnished to the Board to establish a prima facie case regarding the violations set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The Department has determined there are no material facts in dispute and Ms. Trim has waived the right to elect the method of resolution.

Therefore, Ms. Trim was charged with violating Rule 64B11-5.001, Florida Administrative Code (2011), and Sections 456.072(1)(q), 468.217(1)(x), Florida Statutes (2011) constituting disciplinary action.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to make a finding that Ms. Trim was properly served and has waived her right to a formal hearing. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the material facts, as alleged in the Administrative Complaint, are not in dispute, and to adopt the allegations of fact in the Administrative Complaint, as the Board's conclusions of fact in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the allegations of law in the AC, as the Board's conclusions of law in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Ms. Banta and carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the materials under Tab 2 and any addendum materials under Tab 2 in into evidence in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Banta made a motion to impose the following penalties:

- Reprimand
- Suspension of license until compliant with submission of proof of completion of thirty-six (36) hours of general education and four (4) hours of medical errors.
- Suspension of license until compliant with submission of a fine in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and costs in the amount of one hundred twenty-two dollars (\$122.00).

Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried with a 3/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to access the investigative costs of \$448.93 including Suspension of license until compliant. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried with a 3/0 vote.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

### **INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION**

#### **TAB 4 Lianet Guerra, OTA by Examination, file #5455**

Ms. Guerra was not present for the meeting nor represented by counsel.

Ms. Guerra's application was presented to the Board for review of her "Yes" answer to the Disciplinary History questions. Ms. Guerra previously held a Massage Therapy license with the Florida Board of Massage. An administrative complaint was filed February 2, 2012, alleging discrepancies regarding billing or fraudulent billing for services, inconsistencies in documenting patient records, and practicing beyond her scope of practice without required supervision. On May 7, 2012 Ms. Guerra subsequently relinquished her Massage license to avoid further disciplinary issues.

Ms. Guerra was not required to attend this meeting, however, was sent a notification and invited to attend. Ms. Guerra responded with a letter stating she could not attend the meeting due to getting married on Oct 6, 2012 and traveling out of country.

**MOTION:** Following discussion, Mr. Mullings made a motion to request Ms. Guerra to make a personal appearance so the Board can discuss her application for licensure. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried with a 4/0 vote.

### **PERSONAL APPEARANCE**

#### **TAB 5 Bryan Tracy Brown, OTA by Examination, file # 5362**

Mr. Brown was not present for the meeting nor represented by counsel.

Mr. Brown's application was presented to the Board for review at the July 9, 2012 meeting regarding his "Yes" answer to Criminal History questions on the application. Mr. Brown was present for the July 09, 2012 meeting and the Board discussed his history and application. The Board required Mr. Brown to make a Personal Appearance after submitting additional documentation needed to make a decision on his application. The Board requested Mr. Brown to submit documentation for all charges on his level 2 Background Screening report, including certified copies of records related to each charge, specifically regarding the arrest records for the 2008 and 2010 incidents. All records were to be submitted to the Board office 30 days prior to the next meeting of the Board. Mr. Brown submitted several documents, however, was unable to acquire all the requested documentation and sent a letter requesting to make his appearance at the January 7, 2013 meeting. The Board tabled the review of Mr. Brown's application for licensure file until the January 7, 2013 meeting.

### **EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS**

#### **TAB 6 Bryan Tracy Brown, OTA by Examination, file # 5362**

Mr. Brown submitted an exemption from disqualification from employment at the same time of applying for licensure.

The Board tabled the review of Mr. Brown's exemption application for licensure file until the January 7, 2013 meeting.

**TAB 7 Michael David Griffiths, OT 4748**

Mr. Griffith's was not present for the meeting but was represented by counsel, Attorney Ken Metzger.

Mr. Griffiths submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care setting.

**MOTION:** After discussion, Ms. Banta made a motion to approve Mr. Griffith's Exemption for Disqualification from Employment. The motion was seconded by Mr. Mullings and carried 4/0.

**TAB 8 Scott Joseph Vajner, OTA 6840**

Mr. Vajner was present for the meeting, sworn in by the court reporter and not represented by counsel.

Mr. Vajner submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care setting.

**MOTION:** After discussion Ms. Banta made a motion to approve Mr. Vajner's Exemption for Disqualification from Employment. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried 4/0.

At this time, the Board moved the agenda out of order to review the Addendum Exemption application.

**EXEMPTION APPLICATION**

**TAB 21 Camper Antonio Lainez, OTA 12420**

Mr. Lainez was not present for the meeting, nor represented by counsel.

Mr. Lainez submitted an application for Exemption from Disqualification to seek employment in a health care setting.

**MOTION:** After discussion Ms. Banta made a motion to approve Mr. Lainez's exemption for disqualification from employment. The motion was seconded by Mr. Mullings and carried 4/0.

**APPLICANT RATIFICATION LISTS**

**TAB 9 Endorsement Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants**

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve the ratification list of 100 applicants for licensure, including 24 names on an addendum list, totaling 124 names. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

**ACTION TAKEN:** 124 names ratified for licensure by endorsement.

**TAB 10 Examination Candidates: Occupational Therapists & Assistants**

**MOTION:** Ms. Banta moved to approve for licensure, pending the successful passage of the NBCOT examination, ratification list of applicants for licensure as noted, 151 names, including 37 names on an addendum list, totaling 188 names. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

**ACTION TAKEN:** 188 names approved for licensure pending successful exam results.

**TAB 11 Exam With Waiver: Occupational Therapists & Assistants**

**MOTION:** Mr. Mullings moved to approve the ratification list of three (3) applicants for licensure, by Examination with Waiver. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

**ACTION TAKEN:** Three (3) names approved for licensure by exam with waiver.

**TAB 12 Continuing Education Provider Applications**

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson moved to approve the four (4) continuing education providers as listed for ratification, including one, Florida Laws and Rules course. There were no Prevention of Medical Errors courses for approval at this time. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried 4/0.

**ACTION TAKEN:** Four (4) continuing education provider applications, and one Florida Laws and Rules Course approved.

**RULES REVIEW AND OR DEVELOPMENT**

**TAB 13 Regulatory Plan for 2012-2013 Rules for Review**

- 64B11-2.004, F.A.C., Application, Photographs
- 64B11-4.001, F.A.C., Use of Prescription Devices

The listed rules were on the OT Board's Regulatory Plan for 2012-2013 for review.

- **64B11-2.004, F.A.C., Application, Photographs**

**Proposed Action: Repeal:** The intention is to remove the photo requirement from the rules.

**Current Description:** This rule requires a photo be submitted with the licensure application.

**MOTION:** Ms. Banta made a motion to repeal 64B11-2.004, F.A.C. requiring a photograph with the submission of an application. Mr. Mullings seconded the motion, which carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to state the proposed revisions do not have an adverse impact on small businesses. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried with a 4/0 vote.

**MOTION:** Ms. Watson made a motion to state the proposed revisions will not be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after the implementation of the rule. Ms. Banta seconded the motion, which carried with a 4/0 vote.

- **64B11-4.001, F.A.C., Use of Prescription Devices**

**Proposed Action:** Rule Amendment - The Board will update to industry standards, as needed.

Repetitive inquiry is received in the Board office for this rule, regarding the ability for other qualified, licensed practitioners to oversee the supervised treatment sessions, and specifics regarding whether the didactic portion of the course may be completed Online and/or by Live Distance Learning.

**Current Description:** This rule provides the minimum requirements for use of an electrical stimulation device and for an ultrasound device.

The Board discussed specific questions received by Board Staff regarding, whether the didactic portion for a Prescription Devices courses can be completed Online.

After discussion, the Board abandoned any option for online didactic training, and stated all Prescription Devices didactic training must be completed in a live “hands on” course setting.

After discussing students providing Electrical Stimulation or Ultrasound, the Board agreed students will be required to have didactic training in addition to practical training, the same as required in the Prescription Devices Rules.

The Board directed Ms. Norr to draft proposed language for the January 7, 2013 meeting agenda to clarify the didactic training is required first, cannot be obtained online, and “hands on” supervision is required.
