DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS

DETERMINATION OF WAIVER

TAB 1 Krishna C. Mohr, DOH Case No. 2013-13904, OTA10392, File # 3263

(PCP June 3, 2014, Ms. Johnson and Mr. Mullings)

Respondent: Krishna C. Mohr, OTA, P.O. Box 4089, Easton, PA 18043, was initially licensed: 12/1/2006. Respondent was not present, and was not represented by legal counsel.

Ms. Gilani summarized the case for the Board which consisted of a one-count Administrative Complaint which alleges Respondent failed to meet the requirements of the Final Order in Case Number 2011-21031, failing to provide proof of completion of 26 continuing education credits within 90 days of the filing of the Final Order (filed on April 17, 2013).

Respondent was successfully served with Administrative Complaint on June 23, 2014, failed to submit an election of rights or any other responsive pleading within the 21-day period to dispute the allegations contained in the Administrative Complaint. Therefore, Ms. Gilani presented this case before the Board as a determination of waiver, with the following Department's recommended penalty, based on prior discipline and disciplinary guidelines:

- Suspension until Respondent has complied with Final Order in case number 2011-21031 (26 CE hours, \$100 Fine plus \$507.10 costs) as well as the requirements of the Final Order in this case (2013-13904).
- \$1,000 fine
- · Costs (\$82.18)

Prior Discipline:

2011-21031 The case upon which this violation of final order is predicated. A random audit revealed that Respondent failed to comply with the continuing education requirements of license renewal.

Disciplinary Guidelines:

Section 468.217(1)(v), Florida Statutes (2013), First Offense, From suspension until order or subpoena complied with and \$500 fine up to revocation and \$1,500 fine.

MOTION: Mr. Hicks made a motion to find the Respondent was properly served and has relinquished rights to a formal hearing. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the materials in Tab 3 and any addendums into evidence in this proceeding. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the findings of fact as set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

MOTION: Mr. Hicks made a motion to adopt the allegations of law as set forth in the Administrative Complaint and find that this constitutes a violation of the Chapters 486 and 456, Florida Statutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

MOTION: Ms. Carol Watson made a motion to Suspend the Respondents license until compliance with Final Order in case number 2011-21031 as well as the requirements of the Final Order in this case (2013-13904); including a \$1,000 fine and Costs of \$82.18. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 5/0 vote.

Compliance to both orders would include submission of 26 hours of Continuing Education, \$1100 in fines plus \$589.28 in costs (\$1689.28 total).

TAB 5 Thacker, Stefani Suzanne, OT by Examination, File #16173

Ms. Thacker was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

Ms. Thacker was asked to appear to discuss her criminal and personal history. Upon Ms. Thacker's request, Mr. Hicks approved the issuance of a Temporary Permit to allow Ms. Thacker to begin her pending employment on September 5, 2014. The temporary permit was issued valid until the November 3, 2014 Board Meeting.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Heidi Roeck-Simmons made a motion to approve Ms. Thacker's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Tammy McKenzie and carried with a 5/0 vote.

TAB 6 Jadoo, Jeffrey Rajendra, OTA by Examination File # 7101

Mr. Jadoo was not present, nor represented by legal counsel.

Mr. Jadoo's application was presented to the Board for review due to previous criminal and personal history. Mr. Jadoo recently completed his AS/OTA degree at Keiser University on August 22, 2014 and is scheduled for the COTA exam on November 4, 2014.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to require Mr. Jadoo to complete a PRN evaluation and make a personal appearance before the Board for consideration of his application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Roeck-Simmons and carried with a 5/0 vote.

TAB 4 Victoria Salani, OT by Endorsement, File #15651

Ms. Salani and Professionals Resource Network representative, Ms. Martha E. Brown, M.D., Associate Medical Director was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

During the February 2014 meeting of the Board, Ms. Salani was requested to have a PRN evaluation and make a Personal Appearance at one of the next two scheduled meetings of the Board.

Ms. Salani completed the PRN evaluation and entered into a PRN monitoring contract.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion to approve Ms. Salani's application for licensure. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

FIRST APPEARANCE AND MONITOR APPROVAL

TAB 3 Manuel Silva, OTA 13928, File # 5967

Mr. Silva was and Monitor/Supervisor Nivia Binnett was present and sworn in by the court reporter.

During the February 2014 meeting of the Board, Mr. Silva was approved for licensure with the condition of one (1) year of probation under the direct supervision of a monitor approved by the Board.

The Notice of Intent to Approve Licensure with Conditions filed by the Department of Health on March 4, 2014, required Mr. Silva to submit the following prior to the issuance of his conditional license:

- Submission of three (3) curriculum vitas to the Board Chair for temporary approval of a probationary supervisor; and
- Completion of 26 hours of continuing education courses.

Mr. Silva complied with these preliminary requirements and the Board Chair temporarily approved Nivia Binett, Ph.D., OT 4221, as his probationary supervisor on August 22, 2014.

As per the Board's order, Mr. Silva and Ms. Binett were required to make a first appearance before the full Board to obtain formal approval of this supervisory arrangement. Additionally, the Board is to determine the content of the quarterly reports that the supervisor is required to submit in compliance with the order.

Ms. Binnett spoke on behalf of Mr. Silva, complimenting his skills and dedication as a therapist, and discussed their current working dynamics in order to satisfy the Board's requests for Mr. Silva's supervision requirements.

The Board determined the following content for the quarterly reports that the supervisor is required to submit in compliance with Mr. Silva's final order:

- 1) Direct Supervision
- 2) Quarterly Reports to include clinical/patient notes, billing notes/log, performance evaluative criteria (both negative and positives), for approximately 20% of his active patient case load and no less than 25 records annually. Reports should indicate what mode of communication/contact between Mr. Silva and Ms. Binnett transpired, whether by phone, or face to face, etc., and any change of employment and/or company and setting in which services are being provided.

MOTION: After discussion, Mr. Hicks made a motion that no final appearance would be required for Ms. Binnett to attend the Board meeting with Mr. Silva as indicated in the final order as long as there are no extenuating circumstances with the completion of Mr. Silva's supervision. The motion was seconded by Ms. Watson and carried with a 5/0 vote.

MOTION: After discussion, Ms. Watson made a motion for formal approval of Ms. Nivia Binnett as Mr. Silva's Monitor/Supervisor. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 5/0 vote.

Rule 64B11-6.001, F.A.C., Continuing Education Program Approval

Previously the Board approved rule language revisions as submitted by Ms. Norr at the May 19, 2014 Meeting. The new rule revisions, upon the Board's decision were to allow AOTA and FOTA as approved providers to register as rule/statute providers in CE Broker with no fee requirements. The Joint Administrative Procedures Committee submitted concerns in response to the Rule revision, therefore Ms. Loucks requested the Board's feedback in responding to JAPC's correspondence.

Rule 64B11-6.001, F.A.C., Continuing Education Program Approval

MOTION: Ms. Watson moved to accept revised draft of language presented by Ms. Loucks. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hicks and carried with a 5/0 vote.

The Board determined that no SERC was required based on checklist review and thus no adverse impact on small business or increase in regulatory costs.

MOTION: Mr. Hicks moved that the revision does not have an adverse impact on small businesses. The motion was seconded by Mr. Spafford and carried with a 5/0 vote.
